

## 101 CARD

Almost all members regardless of their specialty participate in Emergency Services functions, SAR (Search and Rescue) or DR (Disaster Relief), which include all air and ground operations. They must be qualified and certified to perform those duties. The Members Information Management System (MIMS) keeps all records of ES certification. Members can have a record of their qualifications with them at all times in the form of a 101 Card (CAP Form 101). The first requirement for any ES qualification is the General Emergency Services (GES). It requires completion of CAP tests 116 parts 1 and 2, which is based on CAP Regulation 60-3 or online at <https://tests.cap.af.mil/ops/tests/genes2004.ppt>. The online test can be found at <https://tests.cap.af.mil/ops/tests/default.cfm>. This first ES qualification appears in the National record and the 101 card can be viewed and printed at eServices, My Operations Qualifications/National Reports, Emergency Services at the top of the page. Any additional qualifications will be automatically added as they are approved. See CAPR 60-3 for a complete list of ES specialty ratings.

Members can have their picture added to the 101 Card at CAP Photo Upload in eServices.
