How do I get additional ratings under Emergency Services?

(Specialty Qualification Training Records, sometimes referred to as 'squirts', are check off sheets listing your accomplishments)

Mission Scanner, Mission Observer, and all other ratings under ES require an SQTR for that specific rating, with all requirements signed off. Any squadron member qualified in that rating, plus having SET (Skills Evaluator Training) on their 101 card, is qualified to sign the SQTR. Any task on the SQTR may be covered in a training class or written material. To see individual tasks, they can be viewed at:

After the SQTR is completely signed off the data must be entered by you into the MIMS (Members Information Management System) system through the SQTR Entry window on the same page as SQTR Forms and the 101 card. (See 'SQTR & 101 Card Help' on the previous page.) The data entry will appear on the Emergency Services Officer's computer for approval. That is why he needs copies of all 116 and 117 test certificates and SQTRs. Like the 116 test, the member can complete the 117 test online and print his own certificate with a copy for the ESO.
